The Northern Ireland Festival Committee reserve the right to amalgamate classes with insufficient entry numbers and to change judges to allow for the smooth and efficient running of the show.

In all classes the judge's decision is final.

IMPORTANT:

In the Ridden and Working Hunter Pony classes, competitors must be the correct age for the pony they are riding. The only exception permitted to this rule is where a rider had qualified a pony for a Festival Working Hunter Championship final when they were of the correct age but has since had a birthday. In this case they will be permitted to compete in the Festival WH championship finals at Cavan. However, they must be the correct age for any other classes that they wish to enter.

Stallions: Any Pony Stallion not exceeding 138cms or Small Breed M&M Stallions ie Exmoor, Dartmoor, Shetland, Welsh A or B may NOT be ridden by juniors who have not attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Stallions exceeding 138 cms or Large Breed M&M ie Connemara, Dales, Fells, New Forest, Highland, Welsh C&D may not be ridden by juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Stallions / Colts may not be led by any juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. **Any competitor leading or riding a stallion must wear a RED armband or a stallion disc on the bridle.**

It is the competitors responsibility to ensure your entry meets the conditions of the Northern Ireland Festival Rules in addition to any class specific requirements detailed in this schedule.

Give yourself plenty of time: Please remember classes may run earlier or later than estimated depending on the number of entries who turn up. Listen to the announcer for updates - For this reason we cannot Hold classes or give accurate individual class start times.

HEIGHTS OF M&M PONIES:

All exhibits in M&M classes must be the correct height, as stipulated by their respective Breed Society Stud Book, and hold a valid height certificate to confirm this.

CLASS DETAILS

YOUNG HANDLERS

Young Handler classes are to be judged on the handler's presentation and showing technique and is awarded to the handler, not the pony. Handlers of ponies competing in these classes, aged 14 years and under (class 1), MUST wear a secured current BSI standard Skull / Riding Hat.

Class 1 **Young Handler, aged 7 to 10 years on 1st January in current year**

Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over, not exceeding 153cms.

Class 2 **Young Handler, aged 11 to 16 years on 1st January in current year**

Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over, not exceeding 158cms.

BEGINNER RIDDEN

Class 3 **Tiny Tots Lead Rein**

Lead Rein Show / Show Hunter / M&M Pony, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over, not exceeding 122cms. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein to be attached by the noseband only. Rider to have attained their 3rd birthday by the day of the show, but not to have attained their 6th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 4 **Tiny Tots First Ridden**

First Year First Ridden Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over. Show Pony / Show Hunter Pony not exceeding 122cms or M&M / Part-Bred Pony not exceeding 128cms registered in their approved Pure / Part-Bred Society Stud Book of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Section A or B. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. This must be the first year that the rider has competed off the lead rein.

Class 5 **First Year First Ridden**

First Year First Ridden Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over. Show Pony / Show Hunter Pony not exceeding 122cms or M&M / Part-Bred Pony not exceeding 128cms registered in their approved Pure / Part-Bred Society Stud Book of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Section A or B. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. This must be the first year that the rider has competed off the lead rein.

PONY EQUITATION

Only the rider is judged in these classes, not the pony. Open to any pony. Show class format.

Class 6 **Pony Equitation (rider up to 10 years on 1st January in the current year)**

Pony, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over.

Class 7 **Pony Equitation (rider aged between to 11 and 13 years on 1st January in the current year)**

Pony, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over.

Class 8 **Pony Equitation (rider aged between to 14 and 16 years on 1st January in the current year)**

Pony, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over.

FANCY DRESS CLASSES

Class 9 **Fancy Dress – Children under 10 years** – to be judged in the Evening Performance

Class 10 **Fancy Dress – Adult / Children 10 years & over** – to be judged in the Evening Performance

HOME PRODUCED HORSES

Exhibits in these classes will not be ridden by the judge and will be required to give an individual display.

Class 11 **Home Produced Ridden Hunter**

Home Produced Ridden Hunter, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 01st January in the current year.

Class 12 Home Produced Riding Horse

Home Produced Riding Horse, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 01st January in the current year.

Class 13 Home Produced Ridden Cob

Home Produced Ridden Cob, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 01st January in the current year.

AMATEUR HORSES

Class 14 Amateur Ridden Hunter

Amateur Ridden Hunter, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 01st January in the current year.

Class 15 Amateur Riding Horse

Amateur Riding Horse, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 01st January in the current year.

Class 16 Amateur Ridden Cob

Amateur Ridden Cob, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 01st January in the current year.

LADIES CLASSES

LADIES HUNTER – ASTRIDE

Class 17 Ladies Hunter – to be ridden astride

Ladies Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, to be ridden astride. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year.

JUNIOR SIDE SADDLE

Class 18 Junior Side Saddle, Rider Under 18 Years of Age

Pony Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 158cms, to be ridden side saddle. Rider to be under 18 years of age & of the correct age for the pony they are riding.

LADIES HUNTER – SIDE SADDLE

Class 19 CLASSICAL LADIES SIDE SADDLE QUALIFIER

Open to SSA Adult Members and Non-members, aged 18 and over on January 1st of the current year, riding side saddle, on horses exceeding 148cm (14.2hh). To be judged 25% conformation and action, 25% manners & way of going, 25% rider, and 25% turnout of horse & rider, by a SHBGB, BSHA, BSPS, P(UK) or SSA Panel Judge. Judges may request a short show, but will not ride exhibits; horses will not be stripped. Traditional habits must be worn. Fancy Dress and Period Costumes NOT permitted. Competitors must wear a hat to current Safety Standard or above. Judges are requested to use the mark sheet provided. The highest placed horse/rider combination qualifies for the Final to be held at the National Side Saddle Show. In the event of previous qualification, this may be passed down to fourth place. Special rosettes are offered by Mrs T Mitchell & Mr L Mitchell to the winner and if the winner has already qualified, a second rosette is awarded with the Qualification Card. Qualifying combinations are required to become Full Members of the SSA 21 days prior to the National Side Saddle Show or as soon as possible if qualified after that date to be eligible to compete at the Final. Combinations qualifying between one National Side Saddle Show and the next may carry forward the qualification, for that year only.

The highest placed Riding Horse, Hack (not exceeding 160cm), Cob or Hunter, Mare or Gelding, 4 years and over, ridden by a SSA Adult Member qualifies for the current year's BSHA Championship Show "The Broadband & Phones" Ladies Show Horse Championship and if already qualified the ticket will go to the next highest placed horse down to 5th place. Combinations qualifying after the current year's BSHA Championship Show may carry forward the qualification, to the following year. SSA Members who qualify for The Ladies Show Horse Championship, will not be required to join the BSHA in order to compete in any Side Saddle class at the BSHA National Championship Show. If the BSHA Championship Show entries have closed at the time of qualification, competitors will not be charged a late entry fee for the Championship.

RACEHORSE TO RIDING HORSE

All entries to have raced in either Point to Point or Track and proof must be provided by way of print out from Racing Post / Irish Racing / Turf Club Point to Point and the passport must be available. Blemishes, such as bowed tendons, scars general wear and tear of racing are not taken into consideration and should be ignored.

Class 20 Novice Racehorse to Riding Horse

Novice Racehorse to Riding Horse Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years & over, exceeding 148cms. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

The emphasis is on the ride, obedience, even paces, control and manners. The horse will be required to carry out a short show of walk, trot, canter on the correct lead, gallop returning to halt (which is square) which is held for 5 secs. **The judge will NOT ride the horse in the Novice class**. Riders may ride in either double/pelham or snaffle bits. Spurs may **NOT** be worn in this class.

Class 21 Open Racehorse to Riding Horse

Open Racehorse to Riding Horse Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years & over, exceeding 148cms.

The class will be run as a standard Riding Horse class and the judge should ride the horses – although exceptions may occur at the judge's discretion.

Riders to have achieved their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year.

Suitability as a riding horse will be taken into consideration. However, racing injuries & blemishes must be ignored by the judge - such as pinfired, bowed tendons, scars general wear and tear of racing. The emphasis is on the ride, obedience, even paces, control and manners and suitability as a riding horse.

The horse will be required carry out a short show of walk; trot; few steps of an extended trot; canter on the correct lead; gallop returning to halt, which is square and which is held for 5 secs, and a rein back of a few steps (which should be straight and correct). Riders may ride in either double/pelham or snaffle bits. .

For all working hunter classes, competitors should declare their intention to compete to the gate steward before the class starts.

PERFORMANCE WORKING HUNTER PONIES

These classes are designed to encourage the pony and rider to perform stylishly and are open to both plaited and M&M ponies.

Method of judging:

- A. Ponies will enter the ring individually and jump a course of 10 jumping obstacles designed to produce a maximum of 10 jumping efforts. Course builders are recommended to avoid fences with a related distance.
- B. Each jumping effort will be marked out of 10 – at the judge's discretion.
- C. There is no set penalty for a pole down or run out but three refusals will result in elimination.
- D. A fall of a horse or rider will result in elimination.
- E. There will be no mark awarded for conformation or manners, but a mark will be awarded for the overall impression at the completion of each round – maximum 20 marks.
- F. In the event of a tie, the overall impression mark will determine the final placing. Should there still be an equality of marks, the jumping marks will be taken into consideration – the comparison beginning with fence one and continuing thereafter until a result is achieved.

Class 22 Pony Performance Working Hunter – 55cms (first phase only)

Open to Working Hunter Pony, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over not exceeding 158cms. Maximum height of fences 55cms. Rider any age. First phase only.

Class 23 Pony Performance Working Hunter – 65cms (first phase only)

Open to Working Hunter Pony, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over not exceeding 158cms. Maximum height of fences 65cms. Rider any age. First phase only.

Class 24 Pony Performance Working Hunter – 75cms (first phase only)

Open to Working Hunter Pony, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over not exceeding 158cms. Maximum height of fences 75cms. Riders any age. First phase only.

Class 25 Pony Performance Working Hunter – 85cms (first phase only)

Open to Working Hunter Pony, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over not exceeding 158cms. Maximum height of fences 85cms. Riders any age. First phase only.

Class 26 Pony Performance Working Hunter – 95cms (first phase only)

Open to Working Hunter Pony, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over not exceeding 158cms. Maximum height of fences 95cms. Riders any age. First phase only.

For all working hunter classes, competitors should declare their intention to compete to the gate steward before the class starts.

PERFORMANCE WORKING HUNTER HORSES (phase 1 only)

These classes are designed to encourage the horse and rider to perform stylishly.

Method of judging:

- A. Horses will enter the ring individually and jump a course of 10 jumping obstacles designed to produce a maximum of 10 jumping efforts. Course builders are recommended to avoid fences with a related distance.
- B. Each jumping effort will be marked out of 10 – at the judge's discretion.
- C. There is no set penalty for a pole down or run out but three refusals will result in elimination.
- D. A fall of a horse or rider will result in elimination.
- E. There will be no mark awarded for conformation or manners, but a mark will be awarded for the overall impression at the completion of each round – maximum 20 marks.

- F. In the event of a tie, the overall impression mark will determine the final placing. Should there still be an equality of marks, the jumping marks will be taken into consideration – the comparison beginning with fence one and continuing thereafter until a result is achieved.

Class 27 Horse Performance Working Hunter – 70cms (first phase only)

Open to Working Hunter Horse, Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms. Maximum height of fences 70cms. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year. First phase only.

Class 28 Horse Performance Working Hunter – 80cms (first phase only)

Open to Working Hunter Horse, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms. Maximum height of fences 80cms. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year. First phase only.

Class 29 Irish Draught Performance 80cms (first phase only)

Open to registered Irish Draft Horse, Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms. Maximum height of fences 80cms. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year. First phase only.

Class 30 Horse Performance Working Hunter – 90cms (first phase only)

Open to Working Hunter Horse, Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms. Maximum height of fences 90cms. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year. First phase only.

Class 31 Irish Draught Performance 90cms (first phase only)

Open to registered Irish Draft Horse, Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms. Maximum height of fences 90cms. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year. First phase only.

Class 32 Horse Performance Working Hunter – 1.0m (first phase only)

Open to Working Hunter Horse, Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms. Maximum height of fences 1.0m. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 01st January in the current year. First phase only.

HOME PRODUCED HUNTER HORSES

Exhibits in these classes will not be ridden by the judge and will be required to give an individual display.

Class 33 Home Produced Working Hunter Horse – 75cms

Home Produced Working Hunter Horse, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year.

Class 34 Home Produced Working Hunter Working Hunter Horse – 90cms

Home Produced Cob, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year.

AMATEUR WORKING HUNTER HORSES

Class 35 Amateur Ridden Working Hunter Horse – 75cms

Amateur Working Hunter Horse, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year.

Class 36 Amateur Working Hunter Working Hunter Horse – 90cms

Amateur Cob, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms. Rider to have attained their 14th birthday by 01st January in the current year.

YOUNG RIDERS M&M RIDDEN

Class 37 Young Riders, Intermediate Open Ridden Small and Large Breeds, Rider not exceeding 25 yrs

Open to Intermediate M&M, Small and Large Breeds, Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Section A, B, C or D. Rider not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders must be the correct age to ride a stallion.

Class 38 Young Riders, Open Ridden M&M Large Breeds, Rider not exceeding 18 yrs

Open to M&M Large Breeds, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Fells, Highland, New Forest, Dales, Connemara, Welsh Section C & D. Rider not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 39 Young Riders, Open Ridden M&M Small Breeds, Rider not exceeding 14 yrs

Open to M&M Small Breeds, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Registered in the approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A & B. Rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

PART-BRED RIDDEN

Class 40 Registered Part-Bred Ridden Pony, Not Exceeding 148cms

Open to Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. Exhibits in this section must be registered in the Part-Bred section of their Breed Society / Stud Book. Rider any age.

NB. Stallions must only be ridden by riders who have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year for ponies up to 138cms and riders who have attained their 14th birthday for ponies over 138cms.

Class 41 Registered Part-Bred Ridden Horse / Pony, Exceeding 148cms

Open to Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms. Exhibits in this section must be registered in the Part-Bred section of their Breed Society / Stud Book. Rider any age.

NB. Stallions must only be ridden by riders who have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

NOVICE MINI M&M PONIES

These classes are open to ponies that have not won a first prize at any affiliated Show in an open classification on or before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 42 Novice M&M Lead Rein

Confined Novice Mountain & Moorland Lead Rein Pony, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Registered in the approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B.

Class 43 Novice M&M First Ridden

Confined Novice Mountain & Moorland, First Ridden, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Registered in the approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B.

NOVICE M&M RIDDEN PONIES

These classes are open to horses and ponies that have not won a first prize at any affiliated Show in an open classification on or before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 44 Novice M&M Ridden - Small Breeds

Open to Confined Novice Mountain and Moorland Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over. Registered in the approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A & B.

Rider any age, with the exception of stallions where junior riders must have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 45 Novice M&M Ridden – Large Breeds – Connemara ponies only

Open to Confined Novice Mountain and Moorland Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara. All ponies must have a current height certificate not exceeding 148cms.

Rider any age, with the exception of stallions where junior riders must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 46 Novice M&M Ridden – Large Breeds – excluding Connemara ponies

Open to Confined Novice Mountain and Moorland Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh Section C or D.

Rider any age, with the exception of stallions where junior riders must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

NOVICE M&M WORKING HUNTER PONIES

Novice Mountain and Moorland Working Hunter Pony classes divided by the height of the pony and NOT by the breed.

Confined Novice Mountain and Moorland Working Hunter Pony, Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over. Registered in the Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Section A, B, C or D. These classes are open to horses and ponies that have not won a first prize at any affiliated Show in an open classification on or before the 1st January in the current year. Rider any age. Rider to be the correct age to ride a stallion.

Class 47 Confined Novice M&M Working Hunter Pony – Not Exceeding 122cms

Registered M&M Pony not exceeding 122cms. Rider any age.

Class 48 **Confined Novice M&M Working Hunter Pony – Exc 122cms but not exceeding 133cms**
Registered M&M Pony exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms, rider any age.

Class 49 **Confined Novice M&M Working Hunter Pony – Exc 133cms but not exceeding 143cms**
Registered M&M Pony not exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms, rider any age.

Class 50 **Confined Novice M&M Working Hunter Pony – Exc 143cms**
Registered M&M Pony exceeding 143cms, rider any age.

Beginner Working Hunter

These classes are for true 'Beginner' WH Riders just starting to compete in WH classes. Riders who have won an Open WH class previously will not be eligible. Open to both plaited and M&M Ponies. Course made up of Six Fences.

Class 51 **Lead Rein Working Hunter – Cross Poles.** Pony not exceeding 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday on 1st January in the current year

Class 52 **First Ridden Working Hunter – Fences 30 – 40cms.** Pony not exceeding 128cms. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday on 1st January in the current year

Class 53 **Assisted Working Hunter - Fences 25 - 30cms.** Pony not exceeding 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 10th birthday on 1st January in the current year. Adult to go around with child but must not lead pony.

CONNEMARA WORKING HUNTER PONIES

Class 54 **Connemara Working Hunter Pony – Rider Under 16 years**
Connemara Working Hunter Pony, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years and over. Rider not to have attained their 16th birthday on the 1st January in the current year. Riders of stallions must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Pony to be registered in the approved Pure Breed Society Stud Book of Connemara.
Fence heights will be cc 2'9" (84cms).

Class 55 **Connemara Working Hunter Pony – Rider Over 16 years**
Connemara Working Hunter Pony, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years and over. Rider to be over 16 years on 1st January in the current year. Pony to be registered in the approved Pure Breed Society Stud Book of Connemara.
Fence heights will be cc 3' (92cms).

RIDDEN PONIES

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE PONIES

This competition is for Working Hunters, any weight, mares, geldings or stallion (competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail) four years old or over, exceeding 148cm, to be ridden.

Any horse which has qualified as a Grade A Show Jumper or Advanced Event Horse as at 1st January in the current year is not eligible to compete in Working Hunter classes. All Riders, Owners and Producers must become Members of the British Show Horse Association in order to compete at the Horse of the Year Show. Horses must be registered with the British Show Horse Association in order to compete at the Horse of the Year Show.

Fences will not exceed 1.14m (3ft 9ins) in height, there should be a minimum of 8 fences and a maximum of 12 fences. The course must contain a combination and should contain a water tray. This class will be judged in two parts. Part One (Jumping) will be judged first, without a jumpoff.

All clear rounds and any other horses the judges may require will go forward to the next part. A rider can ride up to two horses in the jumping phase but then must select only one horse to take forward into the ride and conformation section if so required (no change of rider is allowed).
